Maharashtra Badminton Association is pleased to allot your Association the abovereferred Tournament. The following are the Guidelines / Instructions to be observed during the conduct of the said Tournament.

- 1. PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION FOR MULTI-DISTRICT, STATE OPEN, MASTERS, ALL INDIARANKING, INTERNATIONAL RANKING & LEAGUE EVENTS UNDER MBA:
 - i. The tournament organizers will make an application to the concerned District Association. If found OK, the District secretary will forward the same to the Hon Secretary MBA who will check for availability of dates and give approval for the tournament subject to fulfilling of guidelines. From there it will be the responsibility of the District Secretary regarding the smooth conduction of the tournament as per MBA guidelines. In case if the District Association doesn't exist or is dis- affiliated, then the organizer may approach the Hon Secretary MBA with their application. Tournament applications must be received by MBA office minimum One month in advance.
 - ii. No direct tournament application by any individual or Event Management companies shall be entertained unless it is sent through the respective District Association.
 - iii. Tournament applications must be received by MBA office minimum One month in advance.
 - iv. For any application involving Tournament on a League basis, the format of the league auction and all other details must be pre-approved by MBA before the tournament is announced.
 - v. MBA reserves the right to sanction appropriate number of events as per availability of courts and infrastructure. Under no circumstances will the scheduled last match be beyond 9.00pm. The players can be restricted to play in not more than 3 events in cases where it becomes difficult for referee to schedule matches.

2. <u>EVENTS TO BE ORGANISED, TOURNAMENT FEES & ENTRY FEES.</u>

The Tournament organized in the following events and maximum entry fees that could be charged have been mentioned against each of the event. Entry fee will change in case the BAI makes changes in their rules & guidelines.

Please note that the Under <u>9 Yrs event</u> is a non-selection event and it is as such NOT MANDATORY to conduct this event for the Organizers therefore its prize money is not mentioned in the Guidelines.

- BAI/MBA Registration Fees Rs. 100/- per player (to be paid once in a year, beginning on 1st July of every year) to be collected by the respective District Association.
- 50% of Registration Fees collected by District Association should be paid to Maharashtra Badminton Association along with draw copy of District Championship.
 - i. It will be the responsibility of the organizers to collect the entry fees. Organizers shall pay Rs. 200/- per player per entry within 7 days after conclusion of the Tournament received to Maharashtra Badminton Association's account out of which 50% shall be returned to District Association/organizer on completion of all required formalities like submission of draw copy, payments to the umpire and chief referee as per the norms, prize money as advertised etc. (This is applicable to open tournament and league)
 - ii. 5% of the total prize money declared by the organizers shall be given by the organizers to the Maharashtra Badminton Association (for open State and league or National level tournament) within 7 days after conclusion of the Tournament.
 - iii. Point no 1 and 2 is not applicable for selection tournaments.

3. ENTRIES

- i. Entries for Tournaments at all Levels must be routed through MBA Website only. No District Association or organizers can use any other mode of accepting entries except MBA website.
- ii. Entries for Inter District Team Championships must be forwarded on prescribed entry form through District Secretary to Hon. Gen. Secretary, MBA on secretariatemba@gmail.com on association's Letter Head. This format is enclosed herewith Annexure 'A', otherwise the entry will not be accepted.
- iii. All entries are to be approved by the Hon. Secretaries of respective district associations from their District Admin Login before the last date of entry so that the entries can be forwarded to the organizers in time. If not approved by district secretaries, after the last date of entry, a list of all entries will be displayed on MBA website with the assumption that all entries are approved by the respective District Secretaries. The District Secretary shall reject entry in case if they find any player in the list who should not be playing for whatever (disciplinary) reason and inform by sending an email to the Hon. Gen. Secretary, MBA accordingly.
- iv. Please note that no entry will be accepted and forwarded if it is not received in the stipulated time that is mentioned in our online system on www.mbasso.in. In case of exceptions, district secretary must forward late entries/withdrawals to _secretariatemba@gmail.com with a copy to support@mbasso.in, No direct request from players for late entries/withdrawals will be entertained. For State and All India Tournaments Deadline is 48 hours before close of last date of entries. For International Events Deadline is 10 days before close of last date of entries for BWF events.

4. PLAYER ID

i. Hon. District Secretaries should verify that the BAI player ID forms are completed in all aspects as per the BAI guidelines, along with the Affidavit, Birth Certificate, Aadhar card copies as applicable etc. & required Demand Draft and send the applications to the Hon. Gen. Secretary.

5. **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- i. The Players registered with Railways, Petroleum, Air India, other such organizations and Combined Universities can participate in these State Level Open Tournaments and Inter-District Team events only on their birth right or who have domicile status in Maharashtra for a period of at least 6 months prior to the date of Tournament.
- ii. No District Association or organizers can use any other mode of accepting entries except MBA website.

- iii. The district association of the organizing district & MBA shall be kept in picture and their consent should be sought in all organizational matters.
- iv. During the official functions of the tournament the organizing Secretary shall follow the protocol in Consultation with Hon. Secretary MBA. It is advised that minimum 40
 - % of the seats on the dais shall be provided to the officials of the MBA.
- v. <u>Organizers of the Tournament must provide the following minimum facilities at the Tournament Venue:</u>
 - (a) Sound System to be provided at the Referees table during all the Tournament days.
 - (b) Separate dressing rooms for Gents and Ladies, along with clean toilets.
 - (c) Filtered and hygienic Drinking water.
 - (d) One person should exclusively be kept to co-ordinate with media Reporters during the Tournament days
 - (e) A Computer & Printer with Internet facility for using the Tournament Software.
 - (f) A qualified doctor with a basic first aid kit or a Physiotherapist shall be made available all times during the tournament days.
 - (g) Facility for the open draw at venue (Projector, Internet, Laptop, and facility for the live steaming, if available)
- vi. The organizing district applying for conducting of State Multi-District, State Open, Masters, All India Ranking, International Ranking & League Events shall, at the time of application, inform the number of available courts at its disposal to the Hon Secretary MBA. Allocation of the tournament will be at the sole discretion of the Executive council of MBA as recommended by the Hon Secretary MBA. These courts should have wooden flooring / Hova Courts (on wooden surface) properly maintained to provide good playing conditions.
- vii. Hon. Secretary, MBA shall send observer to inspect the venue of the tournament which would include badminton court, Lighting system, Arrangement of Changing rooms for Gents & Ladies, Toilets, Canteen facilities, Seating Arrangements and live draw facility etc.
- viii. The organizing Secretary should take efforts to give proper publicity for the tournament in the local Cable TV, Local News Papers etc. Also, organizers should try to arrange sufficient electronic media coverage for the tournament.
- ix. Organizers are requested to issue a suitable circular giving all the details about the Tournament to all the Hon. Secretaries of affiliated District Associations. Same shall be published and distributed to affiliated District Associations 25-30 days prior to the start of the tournament.
- x. The Addresses of the Hon. Secretaries of Affiliated District Associations are as enclosed in Annexure 'H'.
- xi. In Multi-District, State Open, Masters, All India Ranking, International Ranking &

League Events the organizing District Association will mandatorily use the brand Yonex AS2 with whom MBA has contract. However, for District level tournaments the District Association's contract will prevail over MBA's contract.

- xii. For any open tournament, if there is an involvement of players from more than one district Association but not the entire state it will be termed as a Multi District Tournament for such tournaments all the rules and guidelines of MBA will be applied.
- xiii. All tournament organizers in Maharashtra are hereby informed to take proper permission for conduction of badminton tournament/Exhibition Matches/Leagues etc. Application must be on the letterhead of the registered institution signed by the authorized person sent through the concerned District.
- xiv. For any application involving Tournament on League basis, the format of the league auction and all other details must be pre-approved by MBA before the tournament is announced.
- xv. Organizers who are organizing Masters tournaments should include disclaimer (non- liability) clause in their circulars about the injuries and/or any other medical issue(s) a participant may have due to any reason while playing the tournament, to safeguard themselves. A fitness certificate by a registered Medical Practitioner to be submitted by the players before playing the first match. The presence of a registered Medical Practitioner is mandatory at all times during the tournament.
- xvi. Rules and Regulations regarding conditions to be followed by organizers with respect to the contract of MBA with M/s. Sunrise Sports (I) Pvt. Ltd., are attached in Annexure 'I'.
- xvii. Only Yonex Brand Feather Shuttles should be used for the tournament.

6. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:

- i. The tournament committee shall consist of 5 members from MBA and four to be decided by the organizers. Organizers shall call for a Tournament Committee meeting prior to the tournament, in consultation with the Hon. Gen. Secretary, MBA.
- ii. The address of the representatives of MBA on the Tournament Committee has been annexed for your ready reference in Annexure 'C'
- iii. The members of the Tournament Committee of Maharashtra Badminton Association shall be provided with minimum facilities as under:

On request of any of the Tournament Committee members, the organizers shall make arrangement for their Lodging and Boarding. The expenses for the same shall be borne by the organizers.

Travelling to & fro 2nd AC fare shall be given to all committee members along with Rs. 500 as incidental expenses by organizer.

7. DRAWS:

- <u>- Draws</u> will be take place at the venue one day before the start date of tournament by Chief referee, Dy. Chief referee, match control, tournament organizing secretary, member of tournament committee, member of draw and seeding's committee and observer. In any unavoidable circumstances, the draws will be take place in MBAs office.
- Draws shall be made by using Tournament Planner Software, any change of venue of draw will be intimated to the organizers accordingly.
- In the draws, MBA rankings and BAI rankings (25% of BAI ranking points for 1 to 12 BAI rankings, in singles and 1 to 8 in doubles will be added in MBA ranking points) will be considered. For the first selection tournament points of last years tournament will be considered, for the 2nd selection tournament the ranking points of 1st selection will be considered. And for the 3rd, the ranking points of 1st and 2nd will be considered.
- Preparations of receipt of entries, listing of entries, Draws, Fixtures, Schedule etc. will be done by Chief referee, Dy. Chief referee, match control, tournament organizing secretary.
 - i. The draws shall be displayed by the Organizing Secretary at the Venue as and when received from MBA and also shall be displayed on MBA website by support.

8. REFEREES AND UMPIRES:

- i. MBA Court Officials Committee (COC) in which Hon. Secretary, MBA is the convener in consultationwith COC Chairman, shall nominate Tournament Officials (TOs) for various tournaments.
 - MBA shall appoint 50% Umpires from across various districts of Maharashtra and 50% shall be localUmpires.
- ii. On Conclusion of the Tournament, the organizing secretary should send "TP file" on email to Hon. Secretary, MBA on following address immediately secretariatemba@gmail.com with a copy to support@mbasso.in
- iii. Organizers are requested to get in touch with the Referee for working out details of conducting thetournament with a copy to MBA.
- iv. The minimum facilities and allowances which should be provided / paid to the Technical Officials are enclosed in Annexure 'B'.

- Accommodation provided to technical officials committee members officials etc. should be Air-Conditioned with attached toilets and shall be pre-approved by MBA observer and/or Hon. Secretary, MBA.

D-INCIDENTAL CHARGES

- If the officiating hours in a day exceeds 14 hours, then additional officiating charges @ of half of eligible DA to be paid for the day. A second set of additional officiating charges shall be paid only if the cumulative extra hours of work in the tournament exceeds 6 hours.
- Total Incidental allowance Rs. 800/- for outstation TOS (to and from for travel) These
 payments shall be made for tournament days plus one day extra.

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR THE STATE TEAMS AND ENTRIES FOR OPEN EVENTS IN NATIONALS FOR THE YEAR 2025–2026.

A	General Criteria applicable to all events
<u>.</u> 1	Following points shall be awarded to the player / pair for his performance in the State Selection and State Championships Tournaments. Winner - 400 points. Runner - 300 points. Semi finalist - 200 points. Quarter-finalist - 100 point. Pri- Quarter Finalist - 50 Points When there are 2 or more players involved in a tie (equal points tally) in Singles, Doubles or Mixed Doubles events, a player who has beaten other player/s with equal points in Singles, Doubles or Mixed Doubles in Selection or State Championships, then the unbeaten player's entry shall be forwarded to the National Championship. In case of 2 players with equal points a knockout trial will be taken and incase of more than 2 players with equal points a round robin trial will be conducted.



As per the revised BAI Competition Regulations, there will be Team Championship Event as well as Individual Championship event at the West-Zone Inter-State Badminton Championships which will be schedule during September 2026, hence Maharashtra Badminton Association will conduct for Senior and Juniors (U19 Yrs) either 2 or 1 State Selection/State Championships (as per availability of dates as per BAI Calendar) before September 2025 as Selection events for selection of Individual entries for the West-Zone Inter-State Badminton Championships.

For Sub Junior, Juniors and Seniors - There will be 2 State Selection Tournaments before the west zone tournament. (as per availability of dates as per BAI Calendar). A player must participate in at least one state selection tournament or state championship prior to the west zone championship to be eligible for the selection in the west zone team championship.

However, a player participating in the international tournament during our selection tournaments if they are unable to participate in the state tournament due to their participation in international tournaments they may still be considered. Such cases may be considered by the selection committee in the best interest of Maharashtra team, provided the player is available for the west zone team championship.

For West-Zone Inter-State Championships, every state in entitled to send maximum entries of 10 Men and 10 Women players. In the interest of facilitating higher number of entries from the state for the Nationals, the selection committee select the players who will be given entries for west zone individual events after considering the list of players who have already secured BAI entry on the basis of their National Ranking (BAI Ranking) entries for only those who reached the semifinals in singles and final in doubles in the west zone individual event will be forwarded by the state. In the other words the entries so secured will be player specific and not state specific player who are already ranked in the top 12 in singles and top 6 pairs in doubles are eligible for direct entry from the state as BAI entry.



For Representation of MBA at the West-Zone Inter-State Championships the following shall apply:

Selection of Players for Team Championship Events: The decision of the Selection Committee of MBA in respect of the selection of the State Teams and entries for Open Individual events shall be final and binding on all players. This will be decided by the ranking of the players (MBA ranking and + 25% of the ranking points of BAI ranking 1-12 for singles and 1-8 in doubles) ranking decided from the tournaments of current year before zone tournament. Any international players (BWF ranking below 100) in singles and (Below 50) in doubles and available for west zone can be

For selection of the state teams for Team Championship events the selection committee shall, in the best interest of the state, use its discretion in selecting such players, which will be final and binding on all players. (Explanation: Players attending private camps in India or overseas will not be considered as attendance for the National camps or National Duty). MBA's Selection Committee shall keep in mind the best interest of the team, and select Juniors (U19 yrs) and Senior Teams for West-Zone Inter-State Championships by using their discretion.

<u>Selection of Players for Individual Championship Events:</u>
 The decision of the Selection Committee of MBA in respect of Individual entries shall be final and binding on all players.



While selecting the State Teams for Individual entries, the selection committee shall be guided by the point system. However, in the event of any eventuality such as non-participation of any player due to injury, illness, the Selection Committee in case of individual entries the player would be selected only on the point system of MBA / BAI

- For Individual Entries (Seniors, Juniors & Sub. Juniors, only 2 Entries for Singles Event & 1Entry for Doubles and Mixed Doubles Events)
- <u>FOR SINGLES EVENTS</u>: A player who is ranked No. 2 (as per points gained in selection tournaments) will have to play a trial against that player/s who is higher rank in BAI (first 12 for singles) and (who were on national duty).
- If there will be more then 2 player the no. 2 will be decided by round robin.
- The 1st Ranked Player will be directly selected and will not have to play any trials.
- FOR DOUBLES & MIXED DOUBLES EVENTS: The Pair who is ranked No. 1 (as per points gained in selection tournaments) will have to play a trial against that players/Pair who is higher rank in BAI (FIRST 8 pairs in doubles and mixed doubles) and (who were on national duty).
- If there will be more then 2 pair then no. 1 will be decided by round robin.

- West Zone Inter-State Team Championships shall be for a period of 2 or 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ days.
- Each Team shall consist of total not more than 10 Men, 10 Women, 7 Boys, 7 Girls and 3 team officials who are eligible to participate and for free Hospitality.
- West Zone shall consist of Teams and Players from: Maharashtra, Gujarat, Goa, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh.

It is mandatory that all teams should participate in Zonal Team and Individual Championships this year onwards. The revised pattern of competition regulations is applicable to all BAI Member Associations with immediate effect.



5 <u>WEST ZONE INTERSTATE INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS:</u>

In the interest of facilitating higher number of entries for the Nationals, players who have already secured BAI entry on the basis of their National Ranking (BAI Ranking) the selection committee will select the entries for West-Zone Individual Events.

- For Juniors Girls: 2 Singles, 1 Doubles
- For Junior Mixed Doubles Event: 1 Doubles

- For Seniors Women's Events: 2 Singles, 1 Doubles
- For Seniors Mixed Doubles Event: 1 Doubles

It is mandatory for all Players selected by selection committee in the Team Championships to participate in Individual Championship Events at the West Zone

6 Entries for Main Draw in Nationals :

- For Inter-State Inter-Zonal Championships:
 Only Zonal Winner Team shall be eligible for participation at Nationals.
 - For Individual Entries in Main Draw at Nationals
 - All entries shall be accepted through Member Associations only.

 1 Doubles. (Entries will be finalized by MBA ranking)

 - Zonal Semi Finalists in Singles and Finalists in Doubles.

 - 2 Singles & 1 Doubles from each state/Unit.
 - Host Member Association additional entries in each category 2 Singles &
 1 Doubles. (Entries will be finalized by MBA ranking)

- 7 Individual Entries for Doubles Events at Nationals :
 - (Players who wish to partner any Player from other than Maharashtra State): All plavers who wish to participate in the Doubles/Mixed Doubles Event at the Nationals (for Juniors & Seniors- by virtue of being ranked in top 50 of BWF Ranking List OR being ranked in top 6 of BAI Ranking List) & (for Sub. Juniors U-13yrs, U- 15yrs & U17yrs - by virtue of being ranked in top8 of BAI Ranking List) & partnering any player other than Maharashtra State will have to procure an NOC (No Objection Certificate) from Maharashtra Badminton Association before the 1st start of Selection/Championship Tournament BEFORE THE CLOSE OF ENTRY. These players will not be allowed to participate in the Doubles/Mixed Doubles Events of the

State Selection/State Championship Tournaments in Maharashtra in order to protect the interests of the player/s from the State.

MBA has a contract with M/s Sunrise Sports (I) Pvt. Ltd. This contract and its conditions are binding on all registered players of MBA. Players must wear the official kit provided under this contract during all matches of Inter-State (including West-Zone), National Championships. This contract will supersede all other individual contracts, if any, entered into by a player/official for these tournaments. MBA reserves the rights to restrict a player from participating in the matches in the said tournaments, if they do not abide by the MBA's contract.

Each player shall get only 1 kit even though he/she is selected in the Maharashtra Team for Team Championships OR Individual events at 2 different Nationals. Selected Player/s will have to return back to Maharashtra Badminton Association, the kit which is provided to them if he/she do not participate at the Nationals for which they are selected. Managers of Teams empowered to withdraw entries at the Nationals (on the spot) those who breach the contract and will be debarred for 1 year.

TRAVELLING FOR NATIONAL BADMINTON CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025:

In the last few years MBA was reimbursing Travelling Expenses to players for the Nationals since facing difficulty in booking train tickets in lots. From last year MBA has decided to send players by Air for the Nationals. One lot of Air booking for those who participate in Inter-State Team Events and after 2 days for players those who play in Individual Events and return tickets on last day of the tournament so

that the entire team travels together. MBA doesn't entertain any personal request for travelling separately.
