Entry Requirement

- 1. Players must be members of a Member Association affiliated to the BWF.
- 2. Each Player is allowed to participate in a maximum of 3 Event Category (1 Singles, 1 Doubles and 1 Mixed)
- 3. Players are allowed to participate in different age groups so long as they follow the age eligibility below.
- 4. Players are not allowed to participate in the same event of different age groups, so long as the age eligibility has been met.

Under 19

All players must be under 19 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after 1st January 2007. The minimum age for all players shall be 12 years old, i.e. born on or before 31st December 2012.

Under 17

All players must be under 17 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after 1st January 2009. The minimum age for all players shall be 12 years old, i.e. born on or before 31st December 2012.

Under 15

All players must be under 15 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after 1st January 2011. The minimum age for all players shall be 10 years old, i.e. born on or before 31st December 2014.

All players must be under 13 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after 1st January 2013. The minimum age for all players shall be 8 years old. i.e. born on or before 31st December 2017.
