Number of players/pairs accepted for the main draw: MS - 64, WS

- 64, MD - 32, WD - 32, XD - 48.

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Eligible Players: All badminton players who are eligible to play Junior category and

for BWF Members.

Entries: 11.4 All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry

System.

Entries must be submitted no later than Tuesday October 21, 2025 at 23.59 BWF HQ time (GMT +08.00).

Online Entry

Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF IDnumber. In case you wish to enter players, who do not have a BWF ID-number, please contact the BWF office well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can receive a BWF IDnumber before the closing date of the tournament.

- 11.1 Entries must be made by a Member of which the player/pair is a member. If a Member enters players for a BEC Junior Circuit tournament, these entries shall be made in order of strength in each event.
- 11.8 No late entries will be accepted.
- 12.1 The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organisers can accept cash payments at tournaments.
- 12.2 The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.
- 12.5 Organisers are allowed to refuse entries if Members or their players have outstanding fees from a previous year.

Entry Fees:

- Singles = 40 EUR
- Doubles = 30 EUR per player

Entry fees have to be paid by bank transfer before the event or in cash (EUR) to the organizer during the event.

General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9

Compliance with "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

Conditions:

The tournament will be run strictly in accordance with the Competition Regulations of the BWF and the Regulations for Badminton Europe Junior Circuit 2025.

The tournament will be played on a knock-out system.

In the events of any dispute, the Referee's decision shall be final. No player shall be eligible to compete unless he/she is in good standing with his/her National Association.

Clothing/ Advertising:

According to BE Junior Circuit Regulations:

13.1 Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalised by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.

13.2 It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.

Insurance:

To be arranged by individual participants.

Doping Information:

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and incompetition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

According to Slovak law, Drug Testing may be carried out on a random basis at any time.

Badminton Integrity:

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes: (Code on The Prevention Of The Manipulation Of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and antimatch manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).

Trencin Slovakia

Trencin, the city of around 55k inhabitants, is located in the central-west part of Slovakia, near the border with the Czech Republic. Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia, is around 120 km south of Trencin.

The main highlight of Trencin (and western Slovakia) is Trencin castle, built on the steep hill above the city and towering over the surrounding area. This is one of the most magnificent castles in Slovakia, still mostly intact, and you will surely be impressed with its grandness.

The heart of the city is the main square – Mierové námestie, probably the most lovely place to visit in Trencin and one of the oldest areas of Trencin, where the city was created. Unlike in many other cities in Central Europe, the main square of Trencin is lined with trees adding up to the beauty and charm of the place and inviting to spend more time there.

The numerous cafes and restaurants, many with the outdoor sitting area, are perfect to spend some time in and enjoy the laid-back vibe of Trencin. The square has always been the center of the social, and cultural life of Trencin, and the beautiful townhouses surrounding Mierové námestie are the most sought address in the city.
