If a player is unable to compete due to early departure, he/she shall be penalised by Forfeiture of rewards (removal of Elite Circuit ranking points and shall not be awarded prizes or prize money). Badminton Europe shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed.
Eligible Players	All badminton players who are eligible to play for BWF Members

Conditions of Play	<p>The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and General Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the Badminton Europe's Elite Circuit.</p> <p>The tournament draw sizes are limited to:</p> <p>(a) 100 matches per day (b) 2 rounds per event per day for the main draw (c) no more than 3 qualifying rounds for a maximum of 8 places in any event (d) if more players/pairs enter the competition than the organisers can accept even in the qualifying rounds the BWF World Ranking shall be used to determine the players/pairs whose entries can be accepted into the qualifying draw and which entry to fill any subsequent vacancy that may arise.</p> <p>Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they were entered. Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called.</p> <p>The draw will be performed by Badminton Europe.</p>

Practice Courts/ Facilities	<p>On 26th May, from 5 pm – 8 pm the courts within the venue are put at disposal free of charge. Players can practice on them without registration but should notice that there are only 5 practice courts that might be occupied.</p> <p>In addition players can practice at the VisioLife Sportsclub before or during the tournament (9am – 5pm: 11,-€ / court per hour; 5 pm – 8 pm: 20,-€ / court per hour). Entries	<p>All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System. Entries must be submitted no later than Tuesday 28th April 2026 at 23:59 BWF HQ time (GMT +08.00).</p> <p>Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF ID-number yet, please use the Tournament Software to register new players before the closing date of the tournament. For online entries please use this link: https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/tournament/E447E449-79B8-4779-9A37-225FC585171C</p> <p>No late entries will be accepted.</p> <p>GCR 7.9: “In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF’s regulations and Disciplinary processes.”</p>
Entry Fees	<p>Singles: 65€ per player Doubles: 55€ per player per event</p>
Payment	<p>17.1 The Member that enters a player into a BEC Elite Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organisers can accept cash payment at tournaments.</p> <p>17.2 The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.</p> <p>17.5 Organizers are allowed to refuse entries if Members or their players have outstanding fees from previous years.</p>

Withdrawals	<p>22.1 Any withdrawal after the Monday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member concerned liable to an amount of US\$ 150,00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations).</p> <p>22.2 Any player not showing up for a match at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member concerned liable to an additional amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the “no show” (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations).</p>
Visas	<p>After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member’s responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa.</p> <p>For assistance to the organizers of the visa paperwork, affected players are asked to submit the visa form at the tournament website not later than 1st May 2026.</p> <p>→ Visa form</p>
Minimum Amount of Entries	<p>In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking, i.e. BEC Elite Circuit Ranking and BWF World Ranking.</p> <p>In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, the first published version of the main draw of an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.</p>
Force Majeure	<p>The organising Member can cancel a tournament in case of force majeure. Such cancellation must be announced at least 15 days before the start of the tournament. If a cancellation is announced less than 15 days before the start of the tournament, then the Member organising the tournament is liable for any expenses incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.). Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons because of a cancellation of a tournament.</p>
Prize Money	<p>There is no prize money for this tournament.</p>
Transport	<p>Official points of arrival & Pick-up Locations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bonn main station → Pick-up point: In front of the Intercity hotel • CGN airport → Pick-up point: TotalEnergies petrol station • Train station Siegburg/Bonn → Pick-up point: Exit at platform 6 <p>Transport is free of charge only for players staying at the tournament hotel booked through the organizer (for accommodation booking see below).</p> <p>All players who need transport are asked to inform us the earliest possible, but not later than 15th May 2026, by submitting the transportation form on the tournament website.</p> <p>We will provide a shuttle service from 26 May to 31 May, operating daily from 8:00 am to 11:00 pm. On 26 May, the shuttle service will start at around 12:00 p.m.</p> <p>Exact schedules and pick-up times will be communicated closer to the event. Please note that changes to the shuttle times may still occur.</p> <p>For return trips to the airport or train station before 12pm, pick-up will be at the hotel. After 12pm, the meeting point will be at the venue.</p> <p>If you have an early flight or train to catch, we can assist you in arranging a taxi or guide you on how to get to the airport/train station by public transport. Please either send us a mail or visit the info desk during the tournament.</p> <p>→ Transport Form</p>

	<p>Transport can also be provided for other players from a point of arrival to any hotel in the city area of Bonn but is then charged as follows (pay in cash when accessing transport vehicle):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20,-€ / player from or to one of the train stations • 30,-€ / player from or to CGN airport <p>Coaches travelling with at least two players get free transportation from or to one of the official points of arrival.</p> <p>Transportation between the tournament hotel and the venue will be via public transport (about 10 minutes) and is free of charge for players staying at the tournament hotel.</p> <p>For Hotel-Restaurant „Zur Post“: It is also possible to walk the 1.6km between the tournament hotel and the venue.</p> <p>Tickets for the tram will be provided at the tournament hotel and are valid for the whole city area of Bonn. These tickets can also be purchased at the venue by all other players.</p>
Accommodation	<p>Hotel-Restaurant „Zur Post“ (<i>Distance to venue: 1.6 km</i>) Königswinterer Str. 309 53227 Bonn Germany</p> <p>Single Room: 104 € / night (breakfast included) Double Room: 128 € / night (breakfast included) Triple Room: 156 € / night (breakfast included)</p> <p>Players who wish to stay at the tournament hotel are asked to inform us as early as possible by submitting the accommodation form on the tournament website. Submitting the form is a binding booking, cancellation is not free of charge. We have a limited number of rooms available, which will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that an additional accommodation fee of 7% applies.</p> <p>Rooms are available as single, double, or triple rooms for the entire stay. Changing room types during the stay (e.g., switching from a single to a double room) is not possible. We will send you the invoice after the deadline has passed. The room must be paid in advance of your stay.</p> <p>The number of rooms is limited. Rooms are provided ‘first come, first served’.</p> <p>Players/Coaches booking the tournament hotel through the organizer will receive free transport (see details above).</p> <p>The deadline to book a room in the tournament hotel is Friday, May 8th 2025. → Accommodation Form</p>
Clothing	<p>18.1 Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF.</p> <p>18.2 It is mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts at all time during play in both the qualification and the main draw. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 100,00 EUR.</p>
Medical	<p>A physiotherapist will be present in the Sports hall during the tournament and a medical doctor will be on call. The next hospital (“St. Josef Hospital, Hermannstraße 37, 53225 Bonn”) is 1km away and so is a rescue/fire station.</p>
Doping Information	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).</p> <p>For more information about anti-doping, please visit the BWF website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-doping-overview/</p>
Badminton Integrity	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p>

Waiver	<p>Member and/or Organiser may be liable for claims originating from the damages incurred by the participants and/or any other persons, arising from or in connection to the particular BEC Elite Circuit tournament, according to local Law. Badminton Europe is not liable for any such claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any nature whatsoever, including but not limited to injury or loss to person or property, arising out of or in any way related, directly or indirectly, to the particular BEC Elite Circuit tournament. It is recommended that Members and/or organisers purchase a proper Insurance Policy that would cover their potential legal liability (as in §3.6). The Organisers decline responsibility and covering of costs for possible injuries or other damages. It is up to participants to insure themselves.</p>
Further Information	<p>The organiser will install a streaming service, so the streaming of matches on two selected courts will be possible: The links will be published on the tournament website. Food will be provided at the venue. There will be a cafeteria within the venue where players can purchase drinks and healthy fresh-cooked real-food. The organiser will provide free WiFi at the venue. Within the venue there will be a stringing service.</p>
