Under 19

All players must be under 19 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after **1st January 2008**. The minimum age for all players shall be 12 years old, i.e. born on or before **31st December 2014**.

Under 15

All players must be under 15 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after **1st January 2012**. The minimum age for all players shall be 10 years old, i.e. born on or before **31st December 2016**.

All Players **MUST** have a BWF Player’s ID before submission of the entries.
Players without an BWF ID must contact their National Association Accordingly.

Format of Play

Rally Point System: 3 x 21 points,

Clothing & Advertising	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the competition regulations of Badminton World Federation. (GCR 20 - 24)</p> <p>The player's name on the back of clothing shall be identical with the name registered as the Last Name (or an abbreviation thereof) in the BWF Player database. Last Name is defined as the family name, surname or similar name under the respective naming protocol of the Member count. (GCR 23.3)</p> <p><u>MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Name of the player is MANDATORY from the first day of the event. 2. From Quarter Final onwards, doubles partners must wear clothing of the same colour and similar design. 3. From Quarter Final onwards, opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colours.
On Court Doctor	<p>On Court Doctor will be on duty throughout the competition at the tournament Venue.</p>
Doping Control	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body.
