2. Entry Details

Regulations (Conditions of Play)	This tournament will be conducted in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes and General Competition Regulations (GCR) and the Badminton Oceania Grade 3 Tournament Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final. Clothing and advertising are in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (sections 20-24). The name of the player is MANDATORY on the back of all the players' shirts. The country name is optional, however if it is on the shirt, it must comply with BWF regulations. Quarterfinals onwards GCR 21 regarding clothing colour will apply: • In Singles matches opposing players must wear significantly different coloured clothing. • In doubles matches both players must wear the same colour clothing and opposing pairs must wear significantly different coloured clothing
Scoring	Scoring will be best of three games to 15 points following the Alternative Laws of Badminton (BWF Statutes, Section 4.1.4), according to which: A match consists of best of three games, a game is won by the side which first scores 15 points (minimum difference of two points). When both sides are 14-all, the side that gains a two-point lead first wins the game. If the score becomes 20-all, the side scoring the 21st point first wins the game. In the third game players shall change ends when a side first scores 8 points. This tournament is a part of the BWF Testing Programme for the 3×15 Scoring System. The host will collect match data, and all stakeholders, including Member Association leadership and staff, host organisers and their volunteers, players, coaches, team managers and technical officials will be asked to complete an online survey about their experience with the 3×15 system.

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Entry Fees	All players are required to pay entry fees. The entry fee for international players is USD120.00 The fee for local players is AUD150.00 Member Associations will be invoiced on 01 Oct 2025 with payment due by 06 Oct 2025. Players will not be able to take to the court until their entry fee is paid. The Member Association that enters a player into the tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. Entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn by the time the draw is made. Entry fees are due for all players including any who withdraw once the draw is made. Entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday 11 September 2025 at 23:59 hrs BWF Headquarters time, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.
