<b>Clothing and Advertising Regulations</b>	<p>This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the <a href="#">BWF Statutes, GCR 20-24</a>. This includes the restrictions of certain colours for shirts, shorts, and skirts to avoid issues with virtual advertising on TV courts, as per BWF Statutes, GCR 21.7.</p> <p>BWF Statutes, <a href="#">Section 5.3.7</a> –</p> <p>Suhandinata Cup: Each player of the Team must wear the same colour and design of shirts and shorts or equivalent articles of clothing throughout the match.</p> <p>Eye level Cups: Clothing regulations in regards to colours are outlined in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.7.</p>
<b>Eligible Players</b>	<p>Players are eligible, provided they remain under 19 years of age throughout the calendar year in which the BWF World Junior Championships are held. Players must have been born in <b>2007</b> or later to compete. The BWF may require documentation supporting the age of players. All members submitting players' entries must ensure the eligibility of their players.</p> <p>The BWF shall have the power to reject an entry due to an incorrect date of birth.</p> <p>Under Clause <a href="#">17.2 of the BWF Anti-Doping Regulations</a> (BWF Statutes, Section 2.3), the BWF has selected the BWF World Junior Championships 2025 as an event where players must complete recognised anti-doping education before they participate in the Championships in India.</p> <p>This means that every player participating in the Team and/or Individual Championships must complete an anti-doping education course before they arrive in India for the Championships. This is a mandatory requirement in order to compete at the BWF World Junior Championships 2025.</p> <p>Members must provide the BWF with proof of completion of the anti-doping education for each player going to India no later than <b>Monday 29 September 2025</b> by sending it to Murali Paramasivam <a href="mailto:m.paramasivam@bwf.sport">m.paramasivam@bwf.sport</a> and copying in Andy Hines-Randle <a href="mailto:a.hines-randle@bwf.sport">a.hines-randle@bwf.sport</a></p>
<b>Participant Agreement for Use of Photographs and Videos</b>	<p>Players and all members of the national delegation shall agree to give the BWF and the Tournament Organiser full television and motion picture rights, including permission to film players and members of the national delegation during all matches and activities around the Tournament, for any commercial, news or other purpose together with the right to transfer such rights, including without any compensation.</p>

<b>Educational / Social &amp; Cultural Programme</b>	<p>The BWF and the Hosts will organize an educational/cultural and youth-oriented program for the athletes taking part in the championships.</p> <p>It is expected that all Members will take part in the educational and cultural activities so that your players have the fullest possible enriching experience from their time at the Championships.</p> <p>It will be held on Sunday, 12 October 2025. Further information about the activities will be provided nearer to the Championships date.</p>
<b>Integrity Awareness - iZone</b>	<p>The iZone will have a range of activities for players and Team Managers to get involved in. The activities aim to <i>build integrity awareness</i> (anti-doping / anti-match manipulation).</p> <p>Every team/player must visit the iZone during the Championships. <b>BWF Player Education &amp; Dual Career Programme</b>	<p>The BWF will organize a player education &amp; dual career activation for players taking part in the championships.</p> <p>It is expected that all Member Associations will take part in the activation so that your players have a better understanding of the scholarships and opportunities available to benefit them during and after their badminton career.</p>

<b>Regulations (Conditions of Play) and Competition Format</b>	<p>The BWF World Junior Team Championships 2025 (Suhandinata Cup) will be run in accordance with but not limited to,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <a href="#">The Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes</a>:</li> <li>▪ <a href="#">Section 5.1 - General Competition Regulations (GCR)</a></li> </ul> <p>BWF Council approved the testing of the following new relay system at the YONEX SUNRISE BWF World Junior Team Championships 2025:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Best of three sets where a team who reaches 45 points in relay format wins a set; and</li> <li>▪ A set is composed of matches compromised of one of each event (men's singles, women's singles, men's doubles, women's doubles, mixed doubles).</li> <li>▪ Full details, including regulations and operational procedures, will be communicated to Members.</li> </ul> <p>Team List: Each competing Member shall nominate a Team List to the BWF, from whom its team will be selected for a tie, within the stipulated timeline as per Section 5.3.2 of the BWF Statutes. Team List with no fewer than two males and not fewer than two female players; and not more than total 20 players.</p>
<b>Grant</b>	<p>The BWF shall provide a financial assistance grant intended for less well-resourced Members. However, the grant is only available to teams that have entered the Suhandinata Cup and participate in the Host's cultural activity program.</p>



## Suhandinata Cup – World Junior Teams Championship

Teams who finished in the top 15 of the Suhandinata Cup in either 2023 or 2024 will not be eligible for financial assistance.

### Participation Grant Calculation:

- The participation grant is available for teams to spend on travel and accommodation as follows to eligible teams:
- Eligible teams approximate flight distance (from Capital City of Member to Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport Guwahati Assam - up to 4,000 Km - USD 3,500.
- Eligible teams approximate flight distance - (from Capital City of Member Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport Guwahati Assam between 4,001 Km- 9,000 KM - USD 5,000.
- Eligible teams approximate flight distance - (from Capital City of Member to Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport Guwahati over 9,001 KM - USD 6,500.
- Distances between Capital Cities are established by GPS and are consistent across websites detailing such information. The website the BWF is using for this purpose is [www.timeanddate.com](http://www.timeanddate.com) (click on Calculators tab and select Distance Calculator).

### The Process:

The eligible teams must indicate their desire to be included for consideration for the BWF World Team Junior Championships - Suhandinata Cup 2025's Participation Grant by submitting their participation via the BWF Online Entry System - **before Tuesday, 1 July 2025.**
